



Cassette Roller Blinds




Macassar Blinds is able to offer a wide variety of Cassette Roller Blinds from numerous manufacturers to meet the needs of most clients.

We look at the size of blind needed, the fabric to be used, operating system, location and use before recommending one of the blinds at our disposal. Generally speaking, the larger the blind, the larger the cassette used. As a rule these vary from 40mm² up to 150mm².

These blinds tend to fall into two main categories:

Without side channels:

The cassette is of more aesthetic value and provides a neat finish whilst offering protection to the fabric and mechanism. These blinds will vary from standard dim-out fabrics through to SunScreens and may have some form of side guide, such as a wire or rod.



With side channels:

These blinds can exclude up to 99% of the light entering the windows, depending on the fabric chosen. They have channels that are fixed to the headbox allowing the fabric to be completely enclosed.

When used with SunScreen fabrics, the channels stop any stray shafts of light from hitting computer screens or other light sensitive areas.

The use of Black-Out fabrics with these blinds gives the exclusion levels mentioned above and is suitable for Science Laboratories, Operating Theatres or Audio Visual applications where complete control of the light, or total privacy, are required.



Methods of Operation


These blinds can be operated by side chain, crank handle or electric motor.

Side Chain is used for small blinds or light weight fabrics. Crank handles not only allow manual operation of larger blinds but can be specified to be detachable, meaning no means of moving the blinds needs to be left with them for security or safety reasons. Electric motors are used for large or inaccessible installations and can be operated via simple wall switch, remote control or whole room environment sensors.



Double Blinds

We are able to supply systems where two blinds are packaged in one headbox. It is usual that one of these is a Black-Out fabric, whilst the other may be a Dim-Out or SunScreen. These give the user complete control over their environment from gentle shade through to complete light exclusion.



Fitting to Windows and Doors

There are systems available to us that can be fitted directly to the window or door frame. These are very unobtrusive and are especially suited to 'Tilt & Turn' windows and doors. These can be fitted with a full range of fabrics and are available with side channels or a choice of control methods.
